YOUR BREAST BET YET-SAVING LIVES WITH HUMAN MILK

Our first event of the year will be a milk drive in Tampa on April 10 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. We will be screening potential donors who bring in their frozen breast milk. The milk needs to be labeled with the date it was collected and can be no more than six months old. Mothers should be in excellent health and currently lactating. They must be free of illicit drugs, tobacco and alcohol and be willing to undergo additional screening. The screening will include verbal and written questions as well as blood tests.
